Equipment:The lodge sits at an elevation of 7600 feet, at the western edge of the flattops. Our weather can vary greatly in the fall, so you should be prepared for a variety of weather conditions. By early September, frost is common, and snow can occur at the higher elevations any time from mid September. A properly outfitted hunter will be prepared for rain snow, and sun, the sun is quite strong at this elevation, and can burn skin easily, even on cloudy days.
